Guidelines for Abstracts / Full Papers

Word Count

Short Abstract - 250 – 350 words, Maximum of 5 keywords

Full Paper - Maximum 3000 words with,

- Introduction (Maximum of 350 words)
- Research Questions / Objectives
- Methodology (Maximum of 350 words)
- Results, Discussion, and Conclusion (Maximum of 800 words)
- References
- Paper Size - A4
- Margin –1 inch in all sides
- **Title Page must have**, Title, Author name/s and addresses (institutional affiliations) Email addresses of all the authors
- **Figures and tables** may be embedded in the text body and the respective captions and cross-references should be correctly indicated
- **Figures and Images** should be send in JPG format with at least 1024 x 768 sizes in pixels

SUBMISSION SHOULD BE BASED ON ORIGINAL RESEARCH, WRITTEN IN CLEAR, GRAMMATICAL ENGLISH
