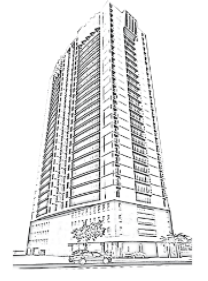

This concerns an advertisement that is currently circulating on social media.

It is necessary to clarify the facts pertaining to an advertisement currently circulating on social media using the text "Ministry of Labor and Foreign Employment".

The advertisement claims the position is a government-approved part-time job and asserts that daily earnings can reach fifty-five thousand Sri Lankan Rupees.

Furthermore, the advertisement mentions that online interviews will be conducted and daily wages will be paid. It also emphasizes the requirement for online job applicants to submit their biographical information.

Deputy Minister of Labour Mahinda Jayasinghe states that the advertisement, which incorporates the text 'Ministry of Labor and Foreign Employment' and the national emblem, is entirely false and misleading. He further emphasizes that the Ministry of Labour has not issued or published such an advertisement."

Furthermore, he highlights that, based on the ministerial portfolios of the current government, the scope of foreign employment does not fall under the purview of this Ministry of Labour.

Legal actions have also been initiated to address the dissemination of such false and misleading advertisements.

Deputy Minister of Labour Mahinda Jayasinghe urges the public against sharing personal information in response to this fraudulent advertisement.
